UP GRADED FOCUS

Traditional workshops in Evidence Based Medicine (EBM) sometimes present potentially conflicting focuses that may confuse participants. Is the goal to become skilled at methodological appraisal of primary studies, at bedside applications of EBM, at teaching EBM?

The NYAM EBEM collaboration is in the forefront of innovation in the development of clinical EBM. The 2008 workshop will reflect important recent advances in understanding and applying a consistently practice-based approach to this subject.

ONLINE COURSEWORK

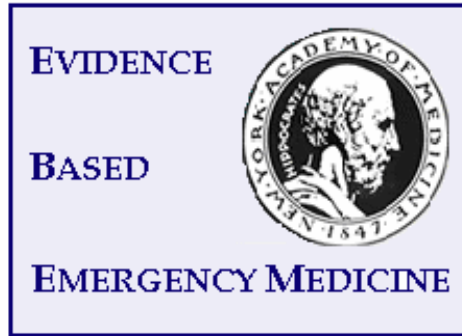
ACCREDITATION
